2007 BERMUDA ONE-TWO DATES

The Notice of Race as well as an Amendment have gone out and are available on the website for download.

- May 19: Deadline for entrant applications, entry fees and skipper/crew resumes
- May 21: Deadline for completing skipper's SH qualifying passage
- June 04: Deadline for arrival in Newport of first-time entrants & returnees with new boats
- June 07 Bermuda One-Two Skipper's Welcome Party
- June 09: Newport to Bermuda Start
- June 22: Bermuda to Newport Start
- June 30: Awards in Newport

WEATHER AND SLEEP SEMINARS

We have two seminars scheduled this year, as was done in 2005, for March 24th and 25th. The Sleep Seminar by Dr. Claudio Stampi is set for Saturday 24 March and a Weather Seminar by Bill Biewenga is scheduled for Sunday 25 March. Both will be held at the Newport Yacht Club. The Sleep Seminar is limited to 15 and the folks that have already asked will get priority for that seminar. The Sleep Seminar has a fee of \$150 per person and the fee for the Weather Seminar will be \$110. however \$250 for both seminars.

DOUBLEHANDED OCEAN RACING TROPHY

This year's Bermuda One-Two race can be used as input to the DH-ORT for those boats that provide an Endorsed IRC certificate in addition to all other requirements. These boats will be scored as a group, in addition to the Bermuda One-Two PHRF scoring, by TIME-ON-TIME using the Endorsed IRC rating and the results will be provided to the DH-ORT officials. These results in no way affect results of the Bermuda One-Two event and no trophies will be awarded to this grouping of boats as part of the Bermuda One-Two event.
