The Notice of Race has gone out and is available on the website for download.

April 01: Non assigned reserved Race Numbers become available

April 27: Deadline for entrant applications, entry fees and skipper/crew resumes

- June 04: Deadline for arrival in Newport of first-time entrants & returnees with new boats
- June 06: Bermuda One-Two Skipper Send Off Party
- June 7: Mandatory SH Leg Skippers' Meeting, Weather and Gulf Stream Briefs
- June 08: Newport to Bermuda Start singlehanded leg
- June 20: Bermuda to Newport Start doublehanded leg
- June 29: Awards in Newport

SEMINARS

SLEEP SEMINAR: We have been running this 2005 by Dr. Claudio Stampi and it has been well received however due to difficulty in getting enough participation there will be no Sleep Seminar this year. DOUBLEHANDED OCEAN RACING TROPHY

This year's Bermuda One-Two race again can be used as input to the DH-ORT for those boats that provide an Endorsed IRC certificate in addition to all the other Bermuda One-Two requirements. These boats will be

scored as a group, in addition to the Bermuda One-Two PHRF scoring, by TIME-ON-TIME using the Endorsed IRC rating and the results will be provided to the DH-ORT officials. These results in no way affect results of the Bermuda One-Two event and no trophies will be awarded to this grouping of boats as part of the Bermuda One-Two event. We have had only two entrants that participated in this, Bjorn Johnson in 2007 and Fred Cosandey in 2011.

POTENTIAL 2013 BERMUDA ONE-TWO SKIPPERS

We have received 1 application for this year's race to date from Dirigo, Eric Johnson and Buck Downes. Last time quite a few people had indicated they would do the race so I predicted around 50. Ooops. It didn't happen. Currently we strongly recommend that satellite phones be carried (rented or bought) however they may be required in the future. They are already required in the Open 6.5 Minis.

OPEN 6.5 MINI AND CLASS 40 BOATS

The Open 6.5 minis tell me they are expecting to put together a class again for this year's Bermuda One-Two. It looks like we should have multiple Class 40s racing this year again.
